Bellwether Behavioral Health provides residential, vocational and behavioral programming for adults (18 years and older) with intellectual/developmental disabilities (I/DD) and challenging behaviors from the state of New Jersey.

Individuals are referred to our community based programs located in the northern, central and southern regions of the state.

All programs are fully licensed by the New Jersey Division of Developmental Disabilities.

Behavior challenges such as aggression, self-injury, property destruction and noncompliance are treated with individualized and Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) designed treatment.



Our programs assist individuals in living fulfilling lives, in less restrictive settings and to safely enjoy recreational and vocational opportunities in the community.

A specialized program is also available in a secure setting for individuals with I/DD and histories of sexual offending.

The new Behavioral Medical Program serves individuals with I/DD and significant behavioral challenges as well as complex medical conditions including insulin dependent diabetes and refractory seizure disorders.
